

We ask you to read carefully this Privacy Policy ("Policy"), which governs how Palmabot Community («Community») collects, uses and discloses the information, when you access or use the website www.palmabot.com (collectively with all of its subdomains and all their respective pages, the "Website"), the online services at the Website ("Services"), or when you otherwise interact with us.

This Policy is an integral part of the Terms of Use of the Website.

1. DEFINITIONS

In addition to the definitions contained elsewhere in the text of this Policy, the following terms and expressions shall have the meaning ascribed to them here below:

"Community Members" means Community and its respective past, present and future actors-business referees, hired employees, officers, directors, contractors, consultants, attorneys, accountants, financial advisors, suppliers, vendors, service providers, parent communities, subsidiaries, affiliates, agents, representatives, predecessors, successors and assigns. "Community Member" means one of the foregoing.

"Data" means the information that is collected in relation to your use of the Website and the Services.

"Terms of Use of the Website" means the document describing the terms of use of the Website available on the Website (as may be amended from time to time).

"User Account" means an account which may be provided to you by Community for improving your experience at the Website and use of the Services, as well as obtaining access to specific additional other products, utilities and offerings provided by Community Members.

2. APPLICABILITY AND ACCEPTANCE OF POLICY

This Policy describes the Data, explains how Data is used and instances when Community shares or permits collection of the Data by the Community Members or state authorities.

This Policy shall enter into force when you first access the Website or commence use of any of the Services. By accessing, browsing or using the Website and/or any of the Services you irrevocably and unconditionally accept and adhere to provisions of this Policy without any exemptions, limitations, and exclusions.

If you access the Website or use any of the Services on behalf of a business (whether registered or operating without registration), that business hereby accepts this Policy.

In the event you disagree with any provision of this Policy or would not like to provide your consent for collection of Data, you shall cease using the Website or any of the Services immediately.

3. COLLECTION OF DATA

To perform the Services and the functionality of the Website, we are entitled to ask you to provide Community Members with your personal identification information, including but not limited to your name, e-mail address, mailing address, phone number, date of birth, a scanned copy of a valid government-issued passport or ID number, information about the used cryptocurrency addresses.

Community Members may collect from you, use and disclose your personal identification information only if you voluntarily provide such information to them. By transferring to a Community Member the Data via the Website or otherwise, you unconditionally entitle Community Member to collect, use and disclose such Data in accordance with this Policy.

Without prejudice to the provisions set out in the Terms of Use of the Website, in the case you do not provide Community Members with the Data or provide them with inaccurate, misleading or incomplete Data, Community Members at their sole discretion shall be entitled, without any notice to you, to:

- impose limitations and restrictions on your use of the Website and/or the Services; and/or
- suspend or terminate your access to the Website, your User Account or the Services.

Community Members may collect the Data from you in a variety of ways and circumstances. Community Members shall be entitled to combine Data collected in the course of your interaction with different sections of the Website or the Services with any other relevant available information.

Data collected by or transmitted to Community Members, in the course of accessing, interaction and operation of the Website and provision of the Services may include, without limitation, the following Data:

- Internet Protocol (IP) address and location;
- cookie information;
- browser identification information;
- information on the computer or mobile device you use to access the Website and the Services, including the hardware model, operating system and version, your web browser, and device identifiers (including a network ID used to communicate with other nodes on the bot);
- information contained in or relating to any communication that you send to us or send through the Website, and metadata associated with the communication;
- date and time of accessing the Website and the Services;
- information of Third Parties' websites referred the Website or the Services;
- information related to your activity in the course of the Services use, including, without limitation, search queries history, search results provided to you in response to your query, web pages you visited by reference from the search results;
- other information (such as API keys and correlated data).

You may always refuse to supply Data, though this may prevent you from engaging in certain Website-related activities.

Data collected hereunder during operation of the Website and provision of the Services may differ depending on whether you access the Website and the Services logged in to your User Account or without logging in.

Unless you are logged in to your User Account Data about you, such as e-mail address, name, mailing address, telephone number, is not collected when you access the Website or the Services. In the event you access the Website or the Services logged in to your User Account, Community Members shall be entitled to associate the respective Data with your User Account and you hereby provide your express and unconditional consent to Community Members for the association of the Data with your User Account.

We may also receive information about you from other sources, such as when logging into your User Account by using your account credentials for a separate Third Party service. We will receive information from that service as indicated in the relevant Third Party's authorization screen.

4. USE OF DATA

Community Members collect the Data as part of the operation of the Website and the Services, including, but not limited to, for the following purposes:

- administration and development of the Website and the Services;
- enhancement of user experience, including the provision of personalized Services and improvement of the Website and the Services;
- development of new products, utilities, and;
- detection, investigation, and prevention of fraudulent transactions and other illegal activities and protection of your rights and rights of Community Members;
- collection, processing and performing statistical and other research and analysis of information for enhancement of the Website and the Services;

- communication with you about products, services, promotions, events and other news and information we think will be of interest to you; and
- verifying compliance with the Terms of Use of the Website.

You hereby acknowledge and agree that Community Members shall be entitled to use cookies and web beacons (pixel tags) to collect the Data and associate the Data with your computer and web browser, as well as, in the event you access the Website and/or the Services logged in to your User Account, with your User Account.

5. PROTECTION OF DATA

We take appropriate security, administrative, and technical measures to protect any personal identification information you provide regarding the collection, storage, and processing, as well as security measures to protect your User Account against unauthorized access, modification, disclosure or destruction of your personal identification information.

The transmission of data or information (including communications by e-mail) over the Internet or other publicly accessible networks is not one hundred percent secure. Community Members are not liable for the security of any data you are transmitting over the Internet, or Third Party content.

Any transactions on the blockchain network are public and Community Members cannot exclude transaction data from the blockchain.

6. DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION

You hereby acknowledge and agree that the Community Members shall be entitled to collect, store, disclose, share and transfer, including cross-border, Data collected from your use of the Website and the Services.

We may disclose the Data, including personal identification information in the following cases:

- you've consented or otherwise given us permission to share;
- with service providers that perform work for us (such as hosting providers, identity verification, support, payment, and e-mail service providers);
- when you use interactive areas of the Services, like our blog or other online forums, certain information you choose to share may be displayed publicly, such as your username, actions you take and any content you post;
- in response to a request for information if we believe disclosure is in accordance with, or required by, any applicable law, regulation or legal process;
- if we believe your actions are inconsistent with our user agreements or policies, or to protect the rights, property, and safety of Community Members or others;
- relating to, or during negotiations of, any merger, sale of community assets, financing or acquisition of all or a portion of our business by another community; and
- between and among Community Members.

Community Members may without limitations share aggregated or de-identified information, which cannot reasonably be used to identify you.

7. RETAINMENT OF INFORMATION

In accordance with applicable laws and as needed to provide the Services to our users, Community Members may hold your Data. This requirement is conditioned by the need of complying with legal obligations and resolving possible disputes.

Community Members may retain your Data so long as your User Account is active. Moreover, your Data may be held beyond the above-mentioned period till it is indispensable for Community Members to have relevant information to respond to any issues that may arise later. Community Members will retain account and personal information for at least five years after an account is closed.

8. ALTERATIONS TO PRIVACY POLICY

We have the right, at our discretion, to update this Policy at any time. We recommend that you frequently check this Policy to find any changes and stay informed about how we help protect the Data. If we make changes in this Policy, we will notify you by revising the date at the top of this policy and by providing an additional notice by adding a statement to the homepage of Community.

By using the Website, you acknowledge and agree that it is your responsibility to periodically review this Policy and be aware of the changes.

The subsequent use of the Website or the Services after changes to this Policy will also be considered as your acceptance of these changes.

9. ACCOUNT INFORMATION AND ACCESS TO INFORMATION

You may access and review or update your online account information at any time by logging into your account. If you want to close your account, please contact us at info@palmabot.com. As mentioned above your Data may be held till it is indispensable for Community Members to have relevant information to respond to any issues that may arise after you close your User Account.

You have a right to access the information we hold about you. You also have the right to rectification, to erasure, to restriction of processing concerning your Personal Data or to object to processing as well as the right to Data portability and to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority. We may ask you to pay a fee before providing you with this information.
